Audio Notes user guide

Basic information about application



1. The first launch

When you start Audio Notes for the first time you will see blank page with cassette picture. This picture you will see always you have no notes.

Now you can only add new note or go to settings. You add note by tapping on the upper right button and by tapping bottom right button you get to app settings.

2. Recording

Immediately after tapping “New” button you start recording audio. You can see big stopwatch showing you time in minutes and seconds.

On the background you can see color gradient from black color to gray color. Background changes its gradient **according recording level**. So if you are in loud room, your background will be darker than in silent room.

Three buttons are used for canceling recording, saving recording and for pausing.



When you **pause recording**, stopwatch stops counting and you will see new button for resuming recording.

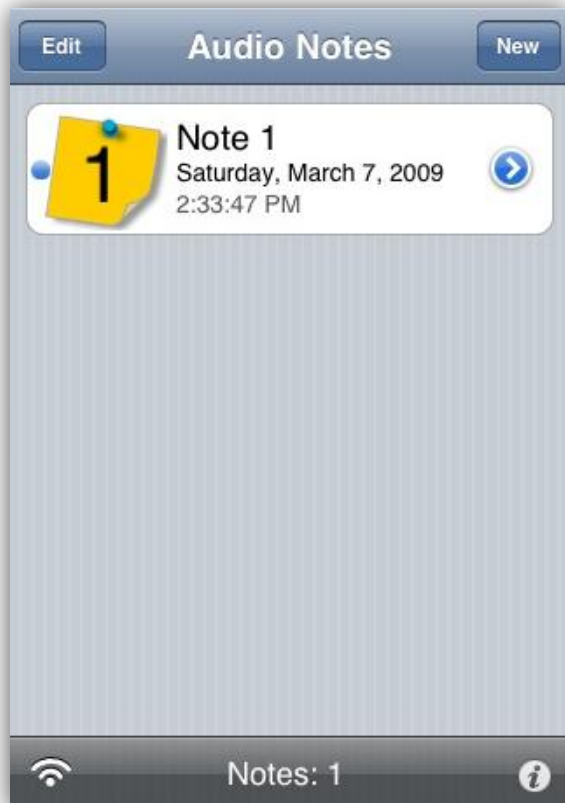
When you record, app automatically enables iPhone **proximity sensor**. So when you hold your iPhone near head, it turns off iPhone screen and you couldn't press any buttons. When recording is done, proximity sensor is turned off.

Audio Notes **continues recording** even if you turn off your screen. This is very useful for longer recording, because you save iPhone battery.

Incoming call causes, that app has to be closed and recording has to be shut down. For this cases app **automatically saves** your records and you can play it after next launch.

3. Showing notes

After saving recording, app sets up new name to note and you will see all your recorded notes. The latest note is above, the oldest bottom. Each row in table shows note name, date and time, when the note was recorded.

You can see also note icon. The color of icon is yellow default, but you can change icon color in note details. Notes, which weren't played yet, show also **small blue dot** on the left side of row. Dot disappears only after playing the note.

If a note is not played yet, you will see also badge on Audio Notes icon on the iPhone main screen.

When you have some notes recorded, you can export, delete or play the note too.



4. Playing the note

Playing the note starts when user taps on the note. On the bottom toolbar you can see pause/play button and slider. Slider is used for **fast rewind**. Tapping pause button you pause playing, tapping play button you resume playing.

If you are playing the note and you tap some other buttons (e.g. edit, new or detail button), playing immediately stops.

5. Deleting notes

For deleting notes you have to switch to edit mode by clicking on "Edit" button on upper left. Then you can delete your notes usually like in other apps on the iPhone.

Bottom right you can see also trash icon. You can use it for deleting all your notes. This cannot be undone.

You can also delete your note by swiping over the row with note.

6. Note details

You can get to note details by tapping the small blue button in the row. You can there **edit note name** or color of note icon. You can choose from 6 different colors – yellow, green, blue, red, orange or violet.

You can also check, how long time you have recorded this note. Time format is in minutes: seconds. When you tap this row, you will see **how many kilobytes or megabytes** note has.

Important is alert section. Here you set up alert for the note. You can choose day, hour and minute.



When you set up the alert for note, you will see this alert after the date you have set up and only **after Audio Notes start!**

This is because of Apple restrictions. No app from App Store can run in the background and no app can add new events into calendar.

Next you can set up note as unread, so you will see small blue dot on the note and also icon badge on the main screen.

The last section is for adding text notes.

7. Exporting your notes

Exporting notes is the best feature in Audio Notes application. It uses **the most advanced**

technology and you can choose from variety of them. This makes exporting the most important function in app.

Unlike in other application, where you can export only one file at once, Audio Notes uses **multi export feature**. This means that you can select multiple files and then send all at once.

You can use both export methods (FTP or e-mail) with **EDGE, 3G or with Wi-Fi**. However with E-mail there are some limitations. If you want to use export function, you have to select bottom left icon in toolbar. This switch audio Notes into **export mode**.

Now you can select notes for export. On the toolbar you can see how many files you have selected and how large they are together.

If you have done, you can select export type in toolbar. Then you will new panel with more export information.

7.1.E-mail sending

NOTE:

Your attachments cannot be over 10MB together, if you want to export them over E-mail

Since iPhone OS 3.0, applications can use in-app sending e-mail. Your e-mails will be sent from your default mail account. Sending mail from audio Notes is as easy as from Mail app, because they have exactly same interface. If you have sent your email already, you don't have to wait until it is sent. You can do your work on iPhone. After sending e-mail you will be notified by sound.

7.2 We Scribe It export

Version 4.0 has brought you ability to export your notes to your We Scribe It account. We Scribe it is transcription service and is provided separately by We Scribe It Company.

In order to export your note to We Scribe It service, you have to be registered in We Scribe It service. All your notes cannot be larger than 50 MB. If you have larger notes, you have to export it manually.

7.3 FTP export

FTP export is basic export function since version 1.1. It is great option for large notes or if you want to send tens of notes at once. FTP export option export your notes to FTP server, which has its unique address. Address can be made my numbers (IP address-169.169.1.1) or by URL (<ftp.example.com>). You can run your own FTP server on your computer too, so you are able to export all notes into Mac or PC. For more information, please visit <http://www.jankuj.com/export.pdf>

8. Application settings

You can get into app settings by touching “i” button in the toolbar.

Auto recording option – after launching Audio Notes, recording starts immediately

User phone receiver – As audio output will be used iPhone receiver on the top

Password – protect your notes by password

Push notifications – only as testing function



Recording quality:

1. *low* - 8 kHz sample rate, 1 minute has about 1 MB
2. *medium* - 22 050 Hz, 1 minute has about 2.5 MB
3. *high* - 44100 Hz (Audio CD), 1 minute has about 5 MB
